

CODE OF ETHICS: RADIATION PROTECTION PROFESSIONAL

These principles are intended to aid individuals certified by the Radiation Protection Certification Committee (RPCC) in maintaining a professional level of ethical conduct. They are intended as guidelines by which individuals may determine the propriety of their conduct.

As a member of the Southern African Radiation Protection Association, I commit to the Code of Ethics of the association and declare as follows

- I will support the objectives of the Radiation Protection Certification Committee.
- I will endeavor to increase the understanding of Radiation Protection.
- I will comply with acknowledged safety standards in practices involving exposure of persons and the environment to ionising radiation.
- In performing my professional duties, I will always give prime consideration to radiation safety.
- I will not perform or undertake to perform work in Radiation Protection for which my education, training or experience does not render them competent.
- I will strive to maintain my professional knowledge and skill.
- Statements made in a professional capacity shall have a scientific basis and be based on sound professional judgement.
- I will maintain high standards in my professional relationships.
- I will maintain the confidentiality of proprietary information.
- I will act upon unacceptable Radiation Protection practices. In so doing, sources of confidential information should be respected, provided ethical principles are not violated.
- I will not engage in illegal activities involving Radiation Protection.
